### RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All photos must have been taken within the previous fair year and must depict an aspect of Massachusetts' agriculture.
2. Entrants must be residents of Massachusetts.
3. No photograph previously exhibited at a specific fair and receiving a first prize can be submitted to another fair.
4. Only one entry per class, per entrant.
5. If less than three entries are submitted for a given class, fair management will combine comparable classes.
6. Photo must have been taken by the entrant, however, commercial processing and printing may be used.
7. All entries must be prints; no smaller than 5x7 inches and no larger than 11x14 inches.
8. Original negative or slide should be available upon request.
9. Photos must be matted and shrink-wrapped but not framed.
10. On 3"x 5" index card, secured to the back right corner of entry, type the following information:
