

# LLAMA SHOW

THE EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL LLAMA SHOW WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 4  
AT 11:00 AM AND FRIDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2007 STARTING AT 9:00 AM.

## RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Entries close on September 15, 2007. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Entry fee: \$25 per animal. NOTE: ENTRIES WITHOUT ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. SPACE IS LIMITED. ENTRIES ACCEPTED IN ORDER OF DATE RECEIVED.
2. Management will use care and diligence for the safety and health of the animals. Neither the Society nor the Committee shall be liable for any loss, injury, or damage which may occur. Entries are accepted on these conditions only.
3. All animals must be registered in the name(s) of the exhibitor(s). All animals must have been owned by exhibitor(s) for at least 30 days prior to the show. Copies of ILR Registrations should be included with 2007 entry form.
4. The Performance classes are limited to only two entries in each class from a single farm (not including youth). Alpacas are encouraged to participate in the performance classes.
5. All llamas must be on the Fairgrounds by 10:00 AM on Thursday, October 4, and off the grounds by 5:00 PM Friday, October 5.
6. All llamas must meet the qualifications for each class: age, sex, and show requirements.
7. This is an ALSA sanctioned show. The show and all exhibitors will abide by all ALSA rules and regulations.
8. We may limit each farm to five entries depending upon the number of total entries received. If you submit more than five entries, and we must limit the number to five, you will be contacted and applicable entry fees will be returned.
9. The show will be held in the Arena; stalling will be in an adjacent tent.
10. This will be a HOBO Show – no grooming required for the llamas.

## HEALTH AND STATE REQUIREMENTS

1. All llamas shall be individually identified by eartag, tattoo or microchip, and this identification shall be listed on the state of origin health certificate. If microchip is used, please bring reader for ID and have it available for use by private, state, or federal regulatory personnel.
2. All llamas must be 5 months of age or older on the day they come to the Fair.
3. All llamas entering the Fairgrounds from out of state must be accompanied by a current, valid health certificate, signed by an accredited veterinarian, certifying that the animals are clinically free of all infectious or contagious disease and exposure from such diseases. These certificates must be available upon request to fair inspectors.
4. Health certificates must be dated January 1, 2007 or later. These documents will be acceptable for the entire fair season in Massachusetts. TB and Brucellosis testing is not required for animals from TB acc. and Brucellosis-free states. All other states should call 617/626-1795 for requirements.
5. Animals must be free from mange, parasites or any other contagious disease. Animals will be inspected upon arrival. Any animal found unhealthy must be removed from the Fairgrounds immediately.
