

Apple Vocabulary

Apple Anatomy

Stem: The stem of the apple attaches the fruit to the apple tree. Its function is to bring water and nutrients to the apple.

Leaves: The leaves are attached to the stem and use photosynthesis to convert sunlight into energy. The water is stored in and travels through veins in the leaf.

Skin: The skin is the outside covering of the apple. It protects the flesh and seeds.

Flesh: The flesh is the firm, juicy, edible part of the apple.

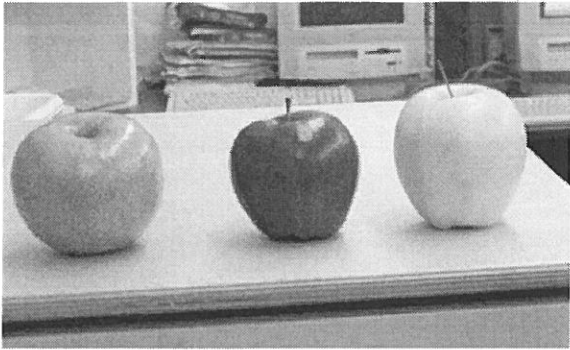
Core: The core is the inner "pocket" of apple that contains the seeds.

Seeds: The seeds of the apple are in the apple's core. Their function is to hold the material needed to grow new apple trees (if planted).
