## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Arrive at the Topsfield Common no later than 8:00 a.m. Saturday, October 5, 2019.
2. Judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. – plan ahead for any last minute details.
3. Judging will be based on the following categories: Best Theme, Best Agricultural, Best Patriotic, Best Youth, and Best Commercial.
4. Premium Awards will be mailed after the fair.
5. Parade will start promptly at 9:00 a.m.
6. Youth and Scout Groups
  - a. Leaders are responsible for safety and for keeping participants on the float
  - b. No carts, bikes, or baby carriages
  - c. Adult leaders should march with each unit and keep group in lined order
  - d. Pick-up of Children: Entrants to proceed to Farm Gate entrance to disband. Parents should park in Lot A/River Gate entrance and meet their children there.
7. Parking
  - a. Buses, cars, and other vehicles may park in Lot D/ Central Street. Inform attendant that you are part of the parade.
