**THE STALK THAT SUPPORTS
THE ANTHOR**

NECTAR

**A SWEET LIQUID REWARD FOR
POLLINATORS THAT IS
PRODUCED BY FLOWER
GLANDS CALLED NECTARIES**

NECTARIES

**THE TISSUE AT THE BASE OF A
FLOWER (SOMETIMES
ELSEWHERE) THAT SECRETES
NECTAR**

OVARY

**THE BASE OF THE FEMALE
PORTION OF THE FLOWER
CONTAINING THE OVULES
WHICH BECOME SEEDS**

PETALS

**THE COLORFUL, THIN
STRUCTURES THAT
SURROUND THE SEXUAL
PARTS OF THE FLOWER AND
NOT ONLY ATTRACT
POLLINATORS BUT ALSO
PROTECT THE PISTIL AND
STAMEN**

PISTIL

**THE FEMALE ELEMENTS OF
THE FLOWER INCLUDING THE
STIGMA, STYLE AND OVARY**

POLLEN GRAINS

**THE POWDERY PARTICLES
THAT CONTAIN THE MALE SEX
CELL (GAMETES); ALSO A
NUTRITIOUS, PROTEIN-RICH
FOOD FOR BEES**

SEPALS

**COMMONLY GREEN, LEAFLIKE
STRUCTURES THAT PROTECT
THE BUD PRIOR TO OPENING**

STAMEN

**THE MALE PART OF THE
FLOWER CONSISTING OF
ANTHER AND FILAMENT**

STIGMA

**STICKY SURFACE WHERE THE
POLLEN LANDS AND
GERMINATES**

STYLE

**THE NARROW REGION OF THE
PISTIL BETWEEN THE STIGMA
AND THE OVARY**
