TOPSFIELD BOARD OF HEALTH ISSUES MASK MANDATE FOR INSIDE BUILDINGS DURING THE TOPSFIELD FAIR

TOPSFIELD, Mass. (September 21, 2021) – The Topsfield Board of Health has issued a mandate requiring anyone attending the 203rd [Topsfield Fair](#), running October 1-11, 2021, to wear a face covering while inside any buildings on the fairgrounds.

The mandate was issued at the board’s most recent meeting, held on September 20, 2021.

“Our goal is to always provide a safe and enjoyable atmosphere at the Topsfield Fair,” said James O’Brien, General Manager, Topsfield Fair. “We will inform people about this mandate on our web site as well as signs posted outside and inside the fairgrounds. In addition to requiring masks inside the buildings, we encourage fairgoers to use the hundreds of hand washing and hand sanitizing stations throughout the fairgrounds and ask anyone that is not feeling well to stay home.”

Regular ticket prices for the 2021 Topsfield Fair are \$15.00 on October 1 and October 4-7 and \$20.00 each on October 8, weekends and Columbus Day (October 11). Discount admission tickets, which offer savings up to \$8 per ticket, are available at www.topsfieldfair.org through September 26, 2021, or at the ticket booth at the main entrance of the fairgrounds until September 30th. General Admission discount tickets can be purchased for only \$12.00, which are good any day during the Fair’s 11-day run. A three-day pass, good any three days, is available for \$30.00. Children under eight with an adult are free. Discounted food vouchers and ride tickets are also available when purchased in advance at www.topsfieldfair.org.
